## our services...

**Individual Support** - a highly flexible and individualized respite experience, which is delivered on a 1:1 basis. Individual Support provides respite and support that is specific to the needs of the child or young person, and is especially beneficial to those who have complex support needs.

**rumpus weekEnds** - Young people should have the opportunity to spend their weekends making new friendships and having FUN. Rumpus Weekends provide meaningful and adventurous group activities 3-4 times a term. Participants are grouped together around age, ability and shared interests to create a unique respite experience. **Camps** - Small group camps are available for those who want to explore parts of Victoria and beyond - make great friendships and have unique adventures full of incredible memories.

**Overnight Respite** - We know how few overnight options currently exist in our community. We do overnight respite differently - being a 10 minute walk from Collendina beach, you could think of it more like a short holiday.

**Rumplings** - Support for children aged 0-6 who have additional needs. It involves the combination of individual 1:1 sessions as well as weekend group activities. It offers great opportunities for children to start accessing the community, and rehearse differing social situations. Free trial periods available.

**Sibling X** - We understand that having a brother or sister with a disability can be challenging and often quite isolating. We are dedicated to sibling support and volunteer our time to try and meet this enormous need in our community.

## our fees...

We strive to provide an innovative high quality service at an incredibly competitive price - charging DHS unit cost, offering group respite packages, and reduced rates if individuals are sharing support staff.

We also don't have managers - and won't expect you to pay for things you don't need. We understand that resources within the disability sector can be limited - we want to assist people to access funding they may be eligible for, and help make it go further.
