Geelong Pizza Cats is a casual catch-up happening after school once a month at the fOrT Youth Services in Corio. The aim is for participants to have fun, be a tad ridiculous, make new friends, and get the support you may be looking for. What we do is completely up to the group - with a range of activities at the facility as well as the nearby park. One thing that never changes is the delicious pizzas we share for dinner.

Some transport may be able to be provided by our volunteers for participants who are unable to attend due to transport difficulties. We can be flexible and will work hard to ensure all young people can be involved.

The group starts when participants are able to arrive after school and goes until 7PM. At this stage they will be held on Wednesdays. There is a \$5 fee per participant to help cover the cost of the pizzas.

All you have to do to be involved is be aged between 11 - 18 years, live in the Geelong region, and have a brother or sister with a disability - it's almost too easy!
